

Legal Alert: Directive from DOI to the Marshals

June 16, 2020

On June 15, 2020, the New York City Department of Investigation sent a memorandum to all New York City Marshals reminding them that all evictions are indefinitely suspended pursuant to the New York State Unified Court System's Administrative Order 68-20.

The memorandum also highlighted the fact that all Notices of Eviction served prior to March 16, 2020 are now deemed stale because thirty days has elapsed since the earliest eviction date specified on those notices. Re-service of these notices will now necessitate seeking permission from the Court.
